ICT Acceptable Use Policy — Children

These rules reflect the content of our school's Online Safety and IT Policy. It is important that parents/carers read and discuss the following statements with their child/(ren), understanding and agreeing to follow the school rules on using ICT, including use of the Internet.

- I will only use ICT in school for school purposes.
- I will not bring equipment e.g. mobile games consoles into school unless specifically asked by my teacher.
- (Year 5 & 6) I will only bring my mobile phone if necessary and will leave it in the office throughout the day.
- I will not deliberately browse, download, upload or forward material that could be considered offensive or illegal.
- I will not attempt to bypass the internet filtering system.
- I will only use the internet and/or online tools when a trusted adult is present.
- I will ensure that my online activity, both in school and outside school will not cause my school, the staff, pupils or others distress or bring them into disrepute.
- I will not deliberately bring in inappropriate electronic materials from home.
- I will not deliberately look for, or access inappropriate websites.
- If I accidentally find anything inappropriate I will tell my teacher immediately.
- I will only communicate online with people a trusted adult has approved.
- I will make sure that all ICT contact with other children and adults is responsible, polite and sensible.
- I will not give out my own, or others', details such as names, phone numbers or home addresses.
- I will not tell other people my ICT passwords.
- I will not arrange to meet anyone that I have met online.
- I will only log onto the school network and learning platforms with my own username and password.
- I will only open/delete my own files.
- I will not attempt to download or install anything on to the school network without permission.
- I will be responsible for my behaviour when using ICT because I know that these rules are to keep me safe.
- I know that my use of ICT can be checked and that my parent/carer contacted if a member of school staff is concerned about my online safety.
- I understand that failure to comply with this Acceptable Use Policy may result in disciplinary steps being taken in line with the school's Behaviour Policy.
