### **Mission Statement**

Crawshawbooth seeks to provide a happy and secure learning environment where a child's natural curiosity is provided with challenges, experiences and opportunities that will enable them to grow into caring, confident and informed citizens of the future.

### **Inclusion**

In Crawshawbooth all curricular subjects will be taught inclusively to all children to take into account their special needs, race, religion, culture, gender, sexual orientation and their family circumstances.

### **Aims To:**

- Ensure that pupils are supported in school, should they suffer bereavement or tragedy within the family.
- Understand that every situation and every school is unique.
- Understand that this is a framework rather than something prescriptive because each situation is unique.

### **Procedure**

- If teacher hears first to inform Headteacher or member of SLT immediately.
- Headteacher to ensure information is correct and ensure relevant members of staff are informed.
- Parents and school to work together to establish the best way to support the children (some parents may not want it discussed with child and others may)
- In agreement with Parents, discuss if outside agencies need to be involved
- In agreement with Parents discuss how school will support the children within school
- Ensure that pupils know who they can discuss things with if they need to

We will review this policy annually or where necessary.
